**CODE OF CONDUCT**

**CONCEPT**

The Bill Dickey Invitational Tournament is aimed at providing a Championship for the best minority junior golfers to further enhance their playing skills. The tournament provides an opportunity for the juniors to play a championship golf course under championship conditions.

**VIOLATIONS OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT ON THE GOLF COURSE**

- Unsportsmanlike conduct including abusive language, club throwing, disrespect of volunteers, officials or fellow competitors, or abuse of golf course property.
- Use of drugs or alcohol, smoking or chewing tobacco products.
- Not adhering to the dress code during practice rounds or tournament play.
- Leaving the course or withdrawing during a competitive round without the permission of Tournament Director.

**DRESS CODE**

- Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward; males must remove hat/visor while indoors at host facility.
- Collared shirts must be worn and tucked in at all times
- Women’s fashion shirts without a collar are acceptable but must have sleeves.
- Men and women’s shorts must be, at least and no more than 4-5” above the knee.
- Slacks and shorts should be neatly belted at the waist.

**PROHIBITED DRESS**

- Tank tops, T-shirts
- Denim shorts, short-shorts, cut-off shorts, gym shorts, jeans

*Proper attire required at all times at the host facility and subject to the discretion of staff of the BDSA.*

**CODE OF CONDUCT VIOLATION PENALTIES**

- One-stroke penalty for each act of unsportsmanlike behavior on the golf course.
- A serious act of unsportsmanlike behavior may result in the player being immediately disqualified from the tournament at the time the violation occurs.
